The first orchestra of youth with developmental disabilities in Korea

Heart to Heart Orchestra, founded in 2006 by Heart to Heart Foundation, is the first non-profit orchestra for young people with developmental disabilities* in Korea.



*A developmental disability refers to a chronic cognitive, emotional, or intellectual impairment which substantially restricts the individuals functioning several major life activities and social interaction. Some of the examples are autism and intellectual disability which are in an increasing trend for the last 10 years.

Musicians from the UK performing with Heart to Heart Orchestra



John Lubbock OBE is well known as the founder and conductor of the Orchestra of St John's. He has single-handedly gathered around him a group of distinguished musicians who are not only outstanding performers but who share his ethos of bringing music to people of all ages and from all walks of life. Besides the orchestra's public concerts, John and his players give around 50 concerts a year in special schools through the charity 'Music For Autism'. In 2015 he was awarded an OBE for services to the Orchestra of St John's and to people with autism and learning difficulties in the UK.



David Junghoon Kim, a South Korean tenor, was formerly a member of the Jette Parker Young Artists Programme at the Royal Opera House. His recent singing roles include Macduff in *Macbeth* (Royal Opera House) and Romeo in *Romeo et Juliette* (Grange Park Opera). He will perform as Edgardo in *Lucia di Lammermoor* (Dorset Opera), Duke in *Rigoletto* (Welsh National Opera), and Rodolfo in *Luisa Miller* (English National Opera). His competition successes include first prize in the Voci Verdiane competition in Busseto at the age of 24.



Haegge Lee, a South Korean soprano, is a member of the Jette Parker Young Artists Programme at the Royal Opera House where she sang the roles of Papagena in *Die Zauberflöte* and Frasquita in *Carmen*. This Season she also sang Sandman in *Hansel and Gretel*, and her plans include covering Marie in *La Fille du régiment*. Her competition successes include first prize in the Concours de Bach in Marseille.
